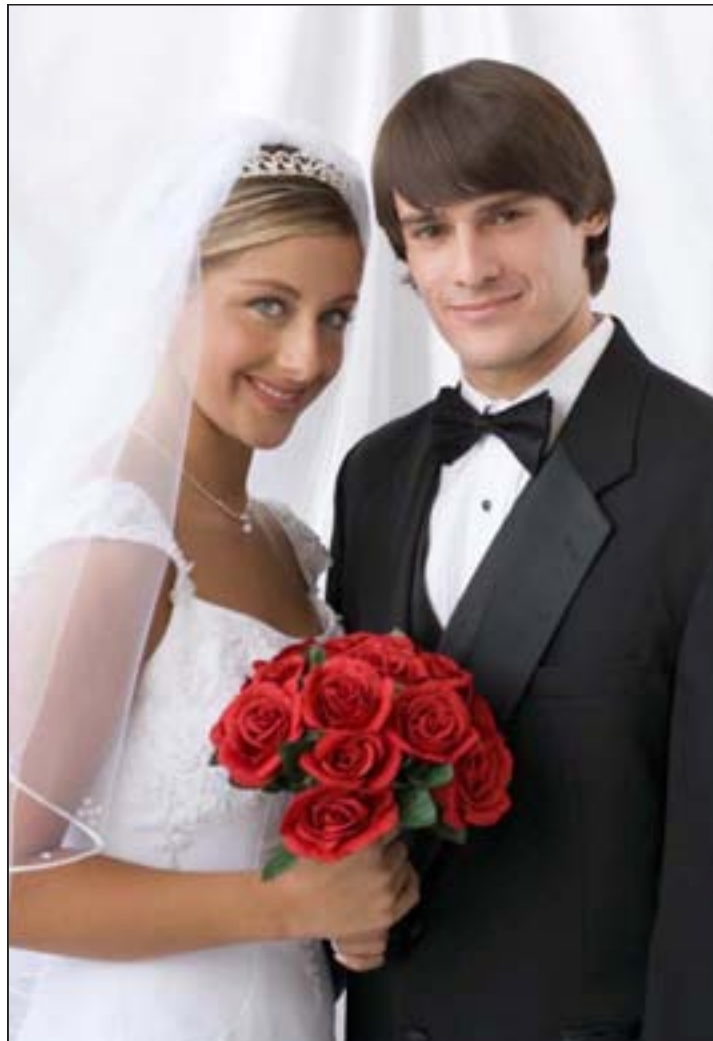
The bridegroom, son of Irene and Bob Greaker of
